

OFFICIAL RULES

1. ORGANIZER - The contest is organised by the Department of Environment, Land and Infrastructure Engineering (DIATI) of Politecnico di Torino (PoliTO).

2. PARTICIPANTS - Participation is open to:

- Professors, researchers, research assistants, PhD students and visiting staff at DIATI
- Technical and administrative staff at DIATI
- Students regularly enrolled in one of the following courses at PoliTO: B.Sc. in Environment and Land Engineering; M.Sc. in Environment and Land Engineering; M.Sc. in Petroleum Engineering; M.Sc. in Petroleum and Mining Engineering.

Such requirement shall be fulfilled at the time of the deadline of the contest.

3. CONTEST THEMES - The contest will accept pictures representing subjects and themes related to environment, land and infrastructure engineering. When sending their pictures, candidates will select one of the following categories:

- 1) Engineering
- 2) Field activities
- 3) Laboratory
- 4) Landscapes
- 5) Microscopy and Macrophotography.

4. TYPE OF PICTURES - The contest will accept pictures in digital format, either jpg or tiff. The minimum size of the long side is 3500 pixel. Both color and black&white photos are eligible. Normal chromatic corrections and corrections of tones, contrast, saturation and levels are accepted. Photomontage and touch-ups are not admitted, as well as frames, dates, signatures and texts added to the picture. Participation to the contest implies that images do not damage any third-party's right. The picture's author guarantees that s/he has obtained any authorization due for images representing people and/or things for those a specific consent is required.

5. SENDING PICTURES - Picture can be sent through the online form: <u>http://bit.ly/fotografiambiente2018</u>. Each author can apply with maximum FIVE pictures. The deadline to send pictures is 31st March 2019.

6. RIGHTS - The ownership and the rights of the pictures remain to their authors. DIATI will have the right to use them and publish them for free, with the obligation to name the author. DIATI cannot give up the rights to use the pictures to third parties.

7. SELECTION OF WINNING PICTURES - At the time of the contest closure (31st March 2019) all the collected pictures fulfilling the requirements of participation will be printed (13x19 cm format) and

showcased in the hall at the ground floor of DIATI -Entrance 3 as well as published on the DIATI Facebook page (<u>https://www.facebook.com/diatipolito</u>). Pictures will be anonymously evaluated by a jury and will be voted by the public. The jury will select the first best picture for each of the 5 categories listed in art.3. The jury's members are:

- Alessandro Vargiu Professional photographer
- Davide Verrecchia Professional photographer
- Silvia Brannetti Media Relations Office of PoliTO
- Silvia Antonietti Project Officer at DIATI
- Domenico Mecca DIATI Students' representative.

Pictures will be also voted by the public through the Facebook page of the Department in the period 1st April - 14th April 2019. Votes will be given through "Likes" to the pictures. The picture gaining the higher number of likes will receive the prize from the public. In case of more than one picture of different authors or of the same author obtaining the same number of likes, the jury will select the one winning the prize from the public.

8. PRIZES - Winners of each of the 5 categories and the winner of the prize from the public will be announced by 19th April 2019. The award will take place on 6th May 2019 during the Conversation at the Library "Lo spazio tra Fotografia e Architettura".

All winning pictures will receive a recognition scroll and may be showcased in poster format in the spaces of DIATI, published on the website <u>www.diati.polito.it</u> and promoted through the Department's social networks. Winning authors will be notified by e-mail. The five winners of the contest and the winner of the prize from the public will receive a printed copy of their picture on aluminum panel (size 30x40 cm).

9. FINAL PROVISIONS - Participation to the contest implies knowledge and acceptance of these official rules.
