CLIMate Adaptation for the PO river basin district

Climate change is leading to great environmental challenges, which require compelling and urgent actions, especially in Southern Europe and the Mediterranean area. From this point of view, the Po River Basin District represents a pilot area for the study of climate adaptation strategies, for two reasons:

- The 87,000 1. district covers about km2, encompassing eight regions and almost a third of the Italian population;
- 2. The district is located in a climatic transition zone between the Mediterranean and Northern Europe, resulting in greater uncertainty about future climate than other European areas, making the area extremely vulnerable to climate change.

Based on this, CLIMAX PO overall objective is to boost adaptation to climate change through climatesmart water resources management at the river basin district scale by implementing NAS (The Italian National Adaptation Strategy) measures tailoredmade on the local characteristics and climatic peculiarities present in the district.

Specifically, CLIMAX PO aims to:

- Improve the governance of climate adaptation:
- Promote shared climate knowledge production;
- Build capacity and awareness in the public, policy makers and technical experts:
- Improve water security and climate resilience:
- Institutionalize climate adaptation in the Po River Basin District.
