

The **PITER ALPIMED CLIMA** project aims to **understand and act on the effects of climate change at the level of the cross-border area.**

Its geographical situation makes the territory particularly vulnerable to the effects of climate change.

The creation of common measurement tools allows to have **a clear vision of the impacts and to promote an effective and sustainable management of resources.**

The aim of the partnership is **to agree on a climate change adaptation strategy for the benefit of the economy and biodiversity** and to **converge behaviour and good practice between public and private actors in the cross-border area.**

The **objectives** of the project are :

- **Consolidating climate data and making them accessible in order to raise awareness of the impacts of climate change**
- **Testing to detect and ensure the development of spatial planning tools** by including good practices to combat climate change
- **Be an example of good environmental practice** and an actor in the fight against climate change
- **Supporting the mountain economy** in the face of climate change
- **Federate actors in the Mediterranean Alps** around common objectives to combat climate change
