# Pedestrian Safety Research: Introduction to Macroscopic Approach and Safety-in-Numbers

Prof. Marco Bassani moderates the discussion

# **ABSTRACT**

Walking has been encouraged not because they economically and environmentally sustainable; but also they can improve public health. At the same time, traffic injuries and involving pedestrians fatalities have been a serious public health problem. This presentation has the following main topics: (1) macroscopic approach to explore safety pedestrian and safety-in-numbers effects pedestrians. The macroscopic safety analysis focuses not only on roadwav desian and characteristics; but also on various factors including but not limited to socio-demographic and climate features. The safety-in-numbers effect is a phenomenon that the probability of crash involvements pedestrian would decreased if the number pedestrian increases. Although a number of previous studies have confirmed the safety-in-numbers effect for pedestrians the effect might not exist in areas with extremely low walking activities. two interesting related to pedestrian safety will be discussed in the presentation.
